Summer Reading Program Passport Instructions & Contest Rules

- Participants must be 18+
- Participants must be RDL card-holders
- Participants will receive a blank passport. They will collect stamps by completing library/reading challenges from a set list or by exploring local businesses.

There are 3 levels of stamps:

Level 1: Stateside

Complete easier challenges at the library to get U.S. state stamps.

Level 2: International

Complete challenges at local businesses or complete harder challenges at the library to get an international stamp.

Level 3: Frequent Flyer

Get the maximum number of stateside and international stamps to get a special frequent flyer stamp.



- In order to receive entries for the drawings, patrons must submit their passports to be counted during the final 2 weeks of July.
- Patrons who get their passports counted get a special RDL stamp (to mark that it's been counted), then get the passport back
- Total number of entries possible: 18

Full List of Stamp Challenges

Level 1: Stateside

- Pick up a passport
- Check out an item from the Library of Things
- Read a book from an author or genre that's new to you
- Attend a library program
- Explore a section of the library that's new to you and check out an item from that section
- Re-read a favorite book
- Read a book from the teen section

Level 2: International

- Complete a challenge at a local business (see list below)
- Record a story for RDL's podcast "If These Woods Could Talk"
- Sign up to help care for the RDL community garden
- Use the hashtag #DiscoverAtRDL and tag RDL in one of your social media posts

Level 3: Frequent Flyer

- Collect all 5 Stateside stamps & 5 International stamps
